


## THIS BOOK BELONGS TO

Carey drops the bottle into the recycling bin. "He shoots he scores!" yells his teammate.




Carey is very happy, but tired and thirsty. He sits in the dressing room. He leans back against the wall. Another player sees how tired he is and gives him a bottle of water.










He drinks a whole bottle of water.

He goes around the goalie pads left on the floor. Finally, he gets to the other side of the room.








Instead, he steps over his hockey bag. He walks past his teammates. What should he do with the empty bottle?
