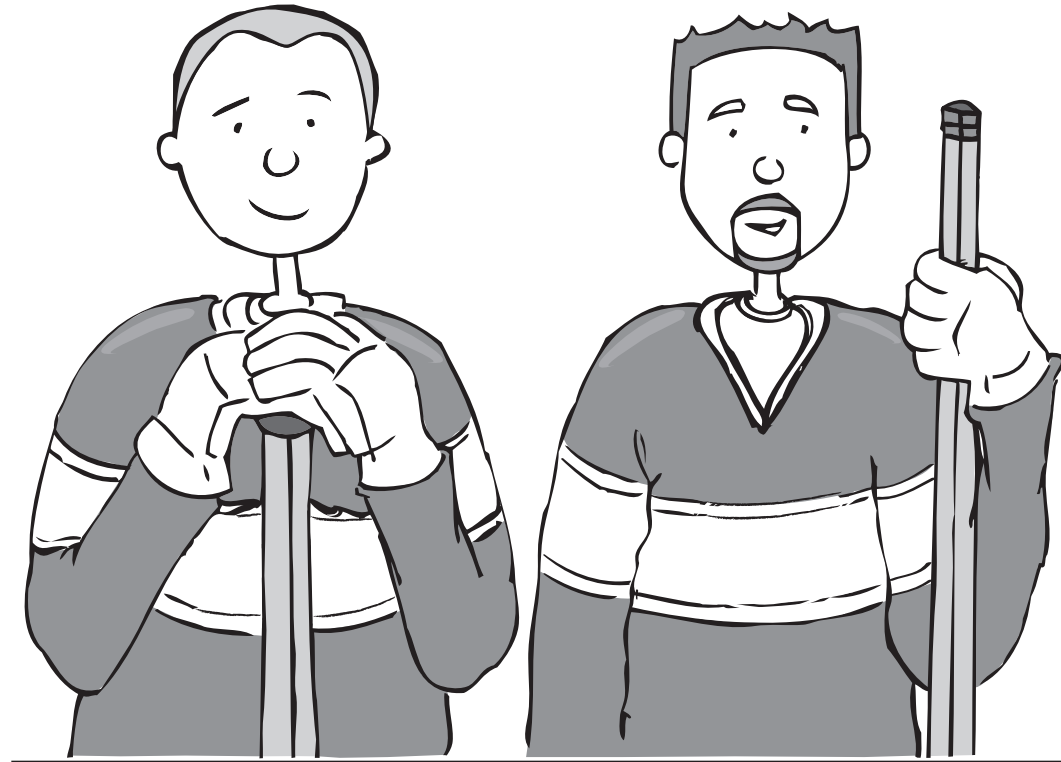

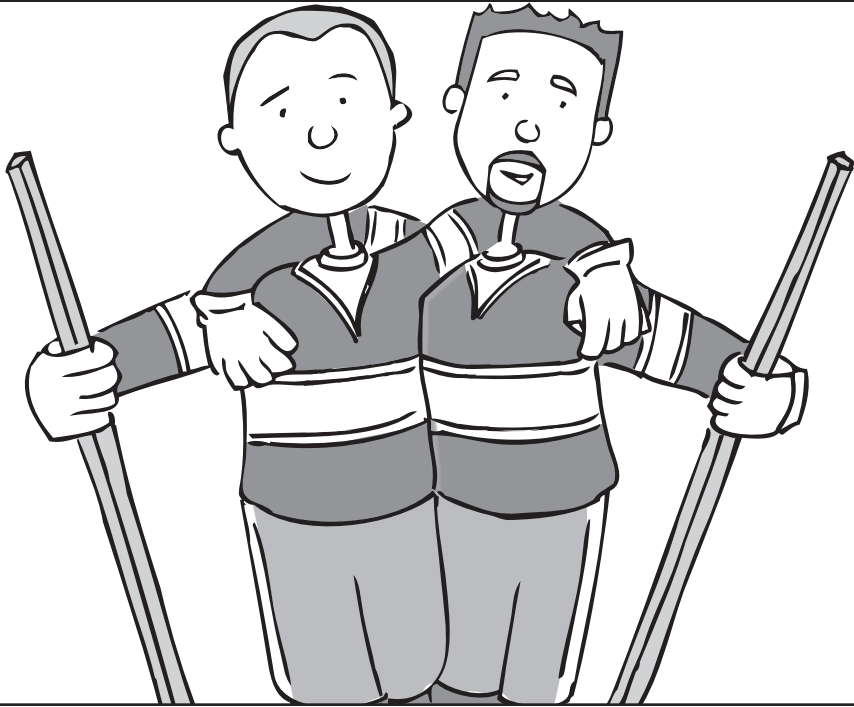

Jonathan and Tomas are friends.



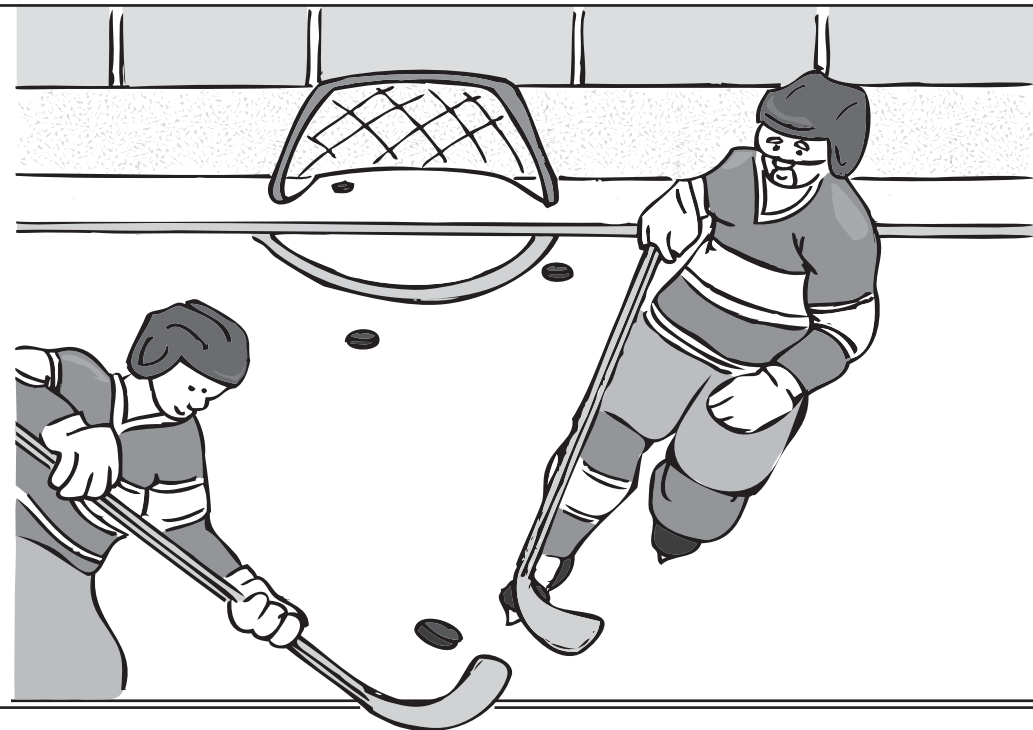

Jonathan and Tomas had co-operated. That means they helped each other. And they helped the Montreal Canadiens win.





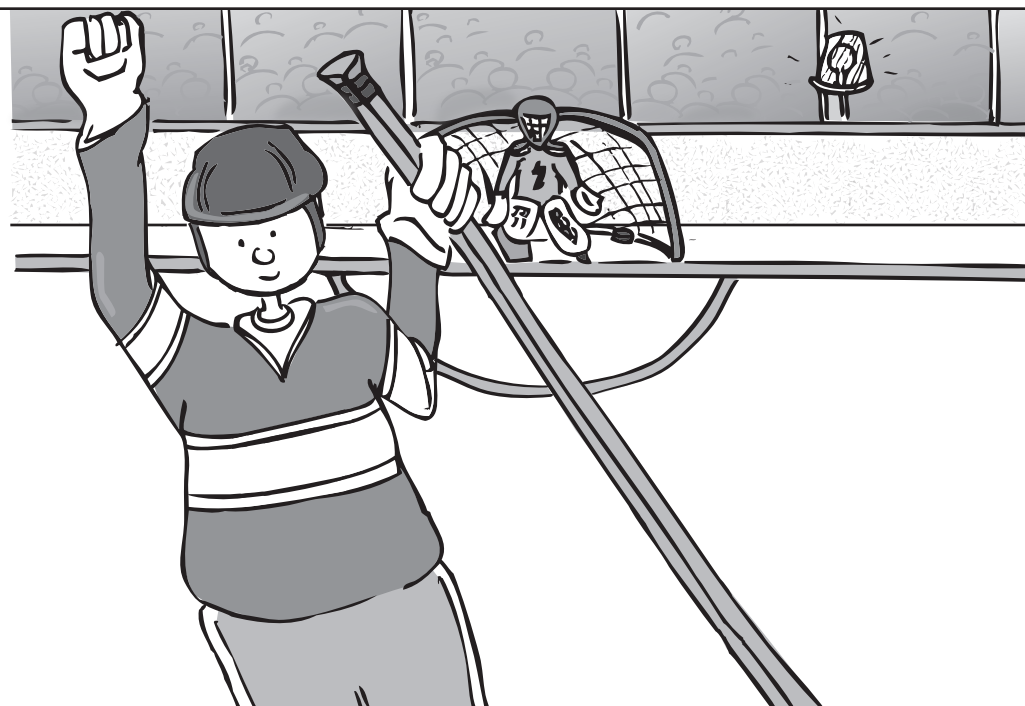
Tomas skates to Jonathan. "Good goal,"

each other helps the team win.



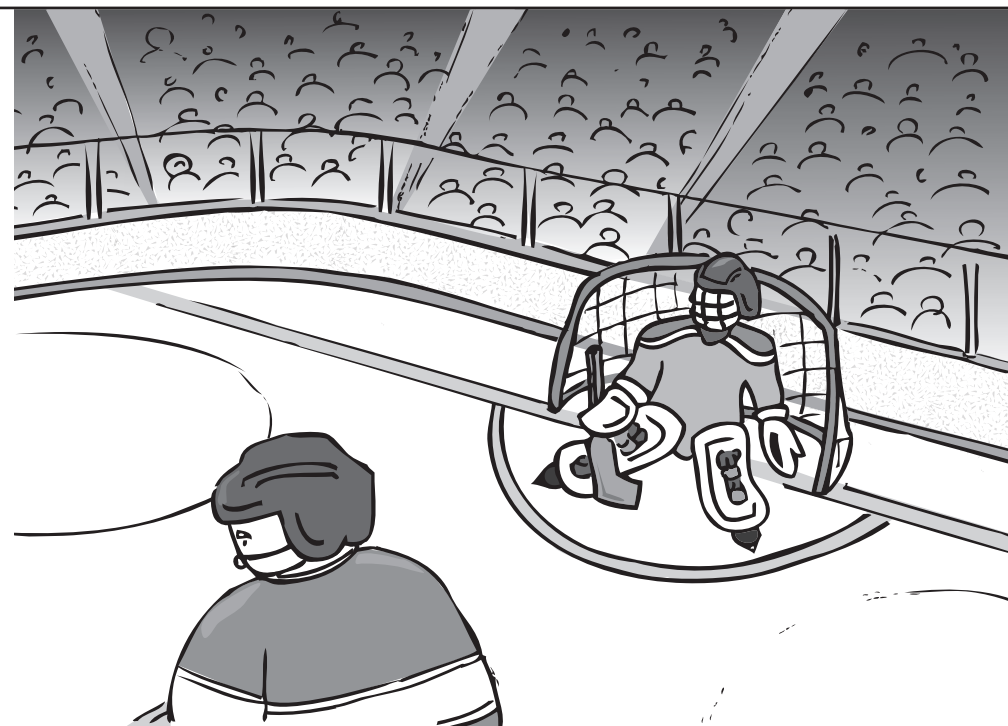
One day, the score is tied. Jonathan has the puck. He skates fast at the other team's net. Tomas skates fast beside him.



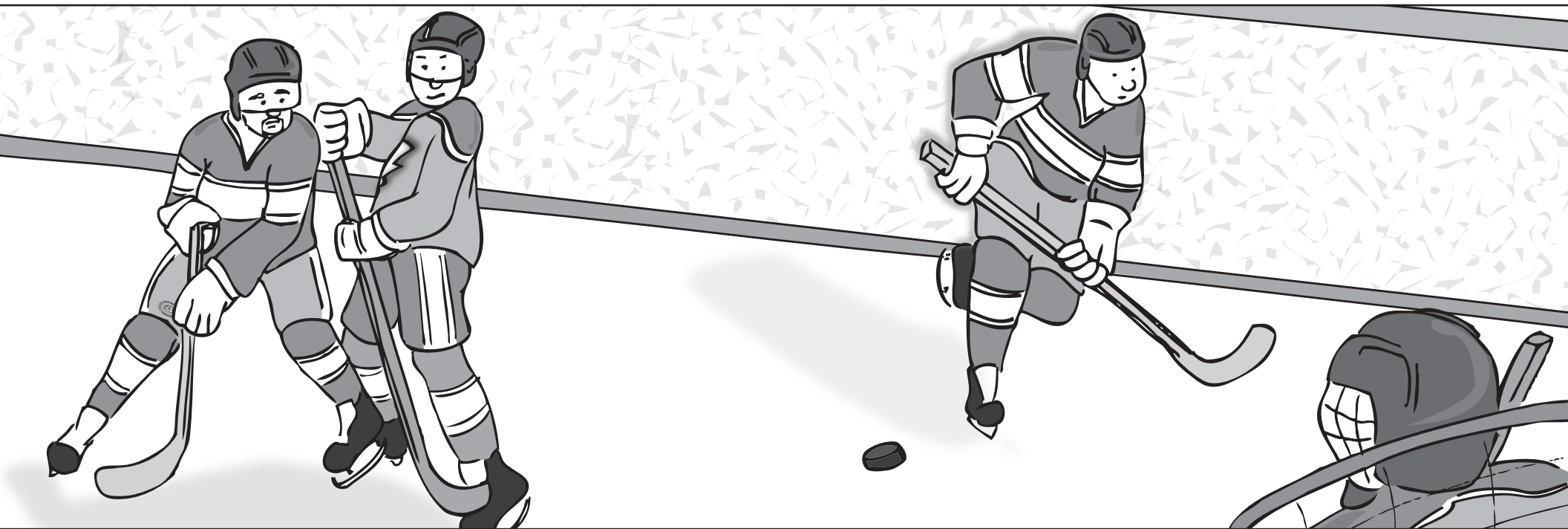
