talks to the team in the dressing room.





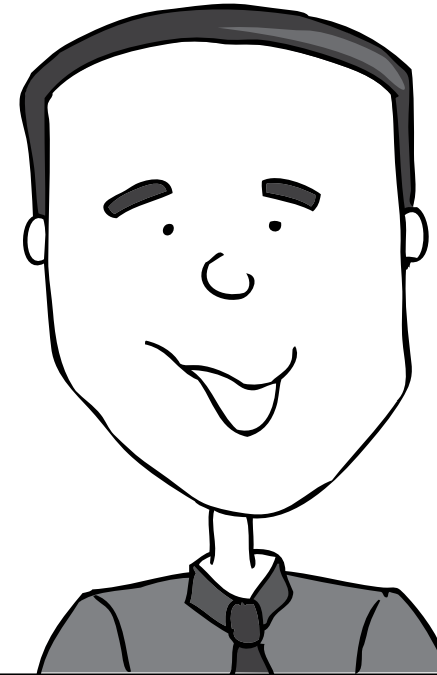
“Now let’s go out and win!”

back. He takes a slapshot.

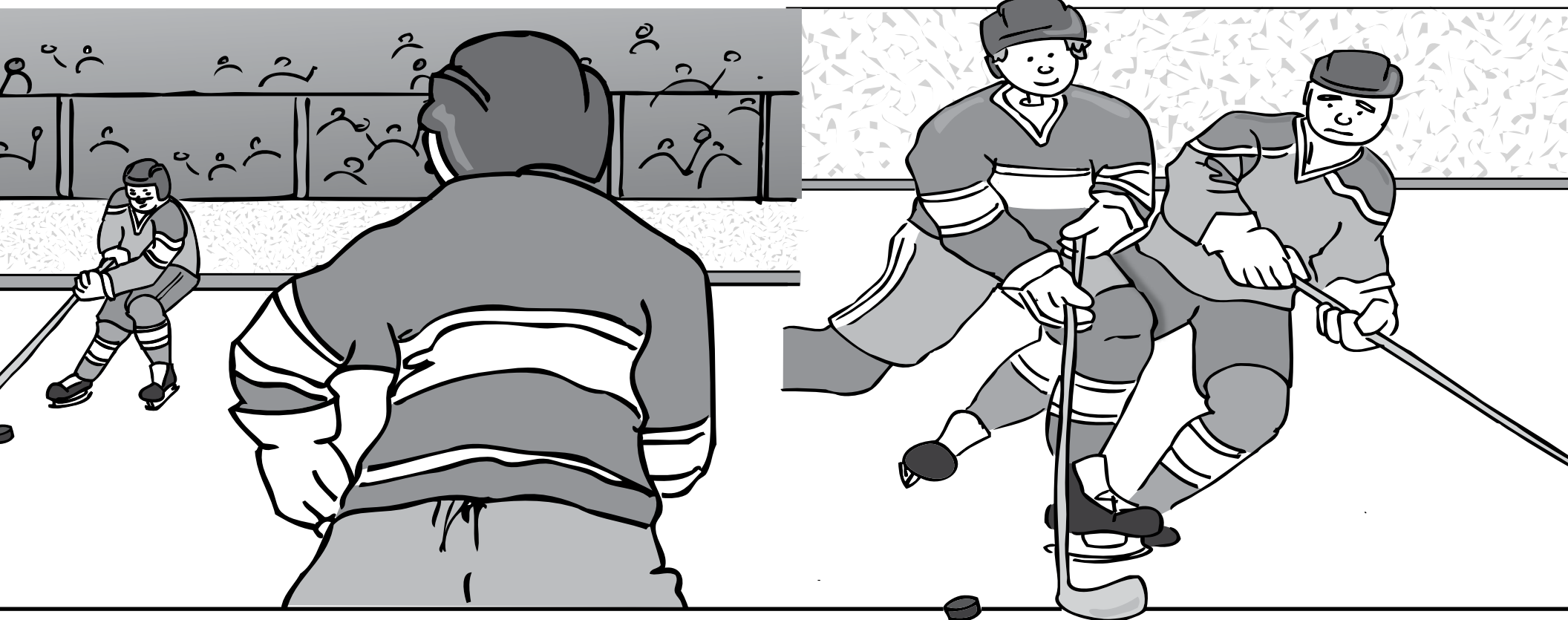


He scores! Max and his Canadiens teammates are playing by the rules. The Canadiens win the game.
