In the morning, Jeff wakes up hungry.

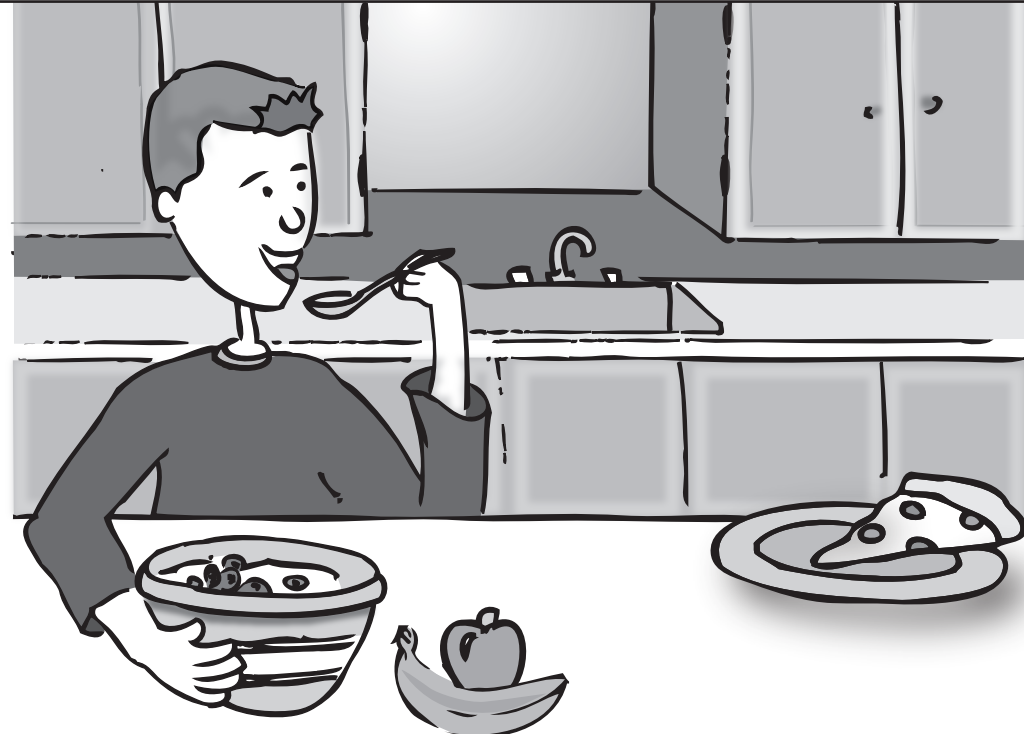


It makes him feel good that he has been responsible all day long.

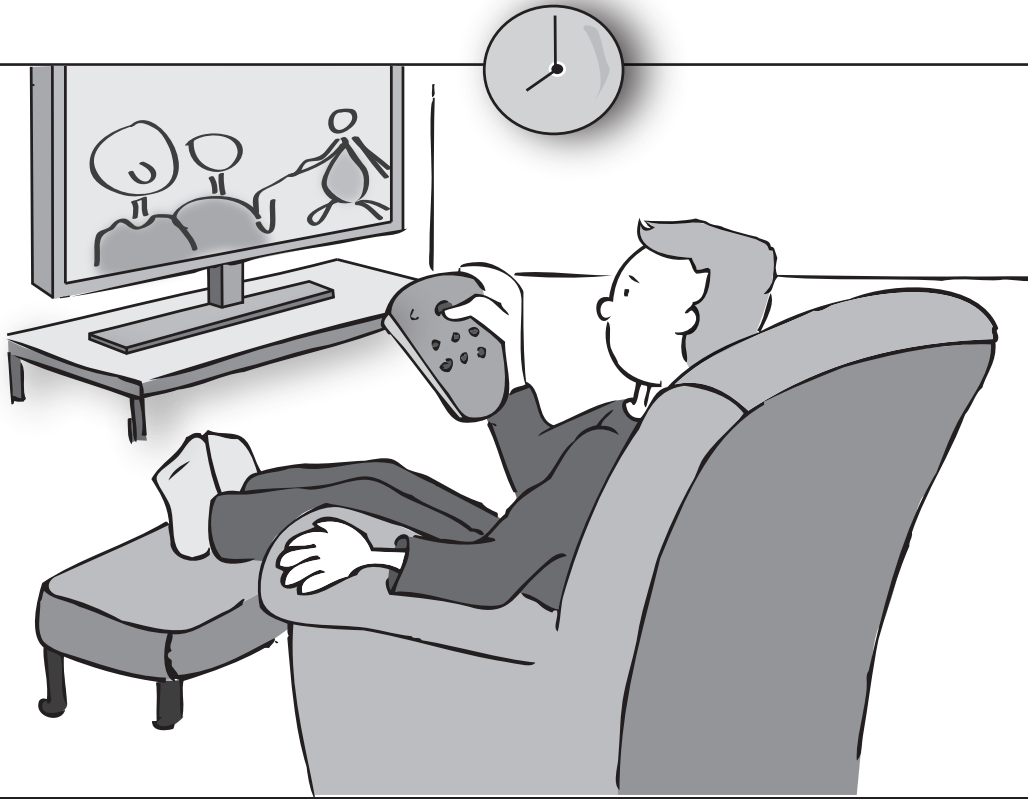




Then he signs some autographs for the fans.

smiles and waves at them.



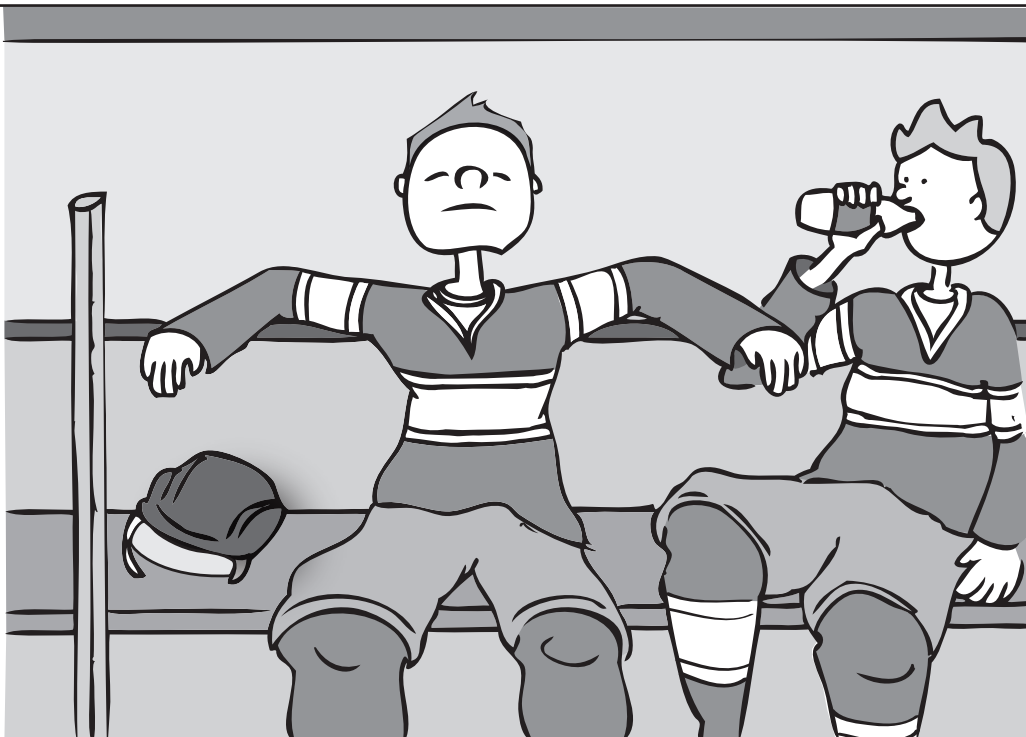
His stomach growls like a lion. Jeff sees

breakfast will help keep his body strong.



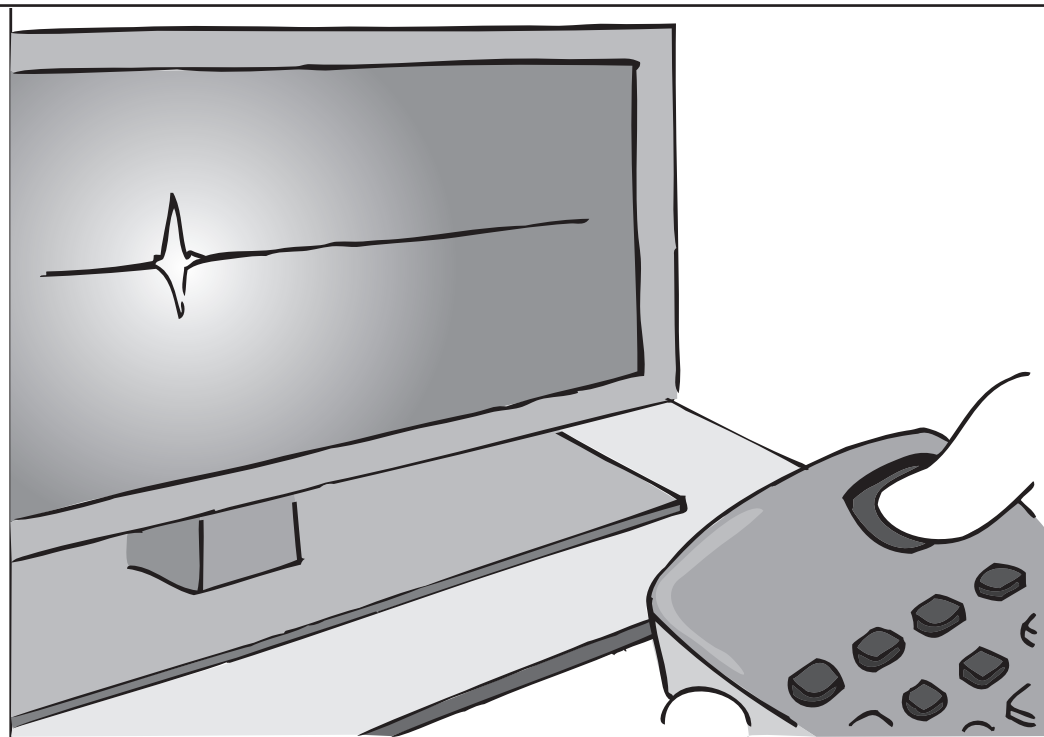
It is eight o'clock. Jeff is watching his favorite morning show. Jeff has to be at the arena before nine.



He gets dressed and goes out to meet with the reporters.



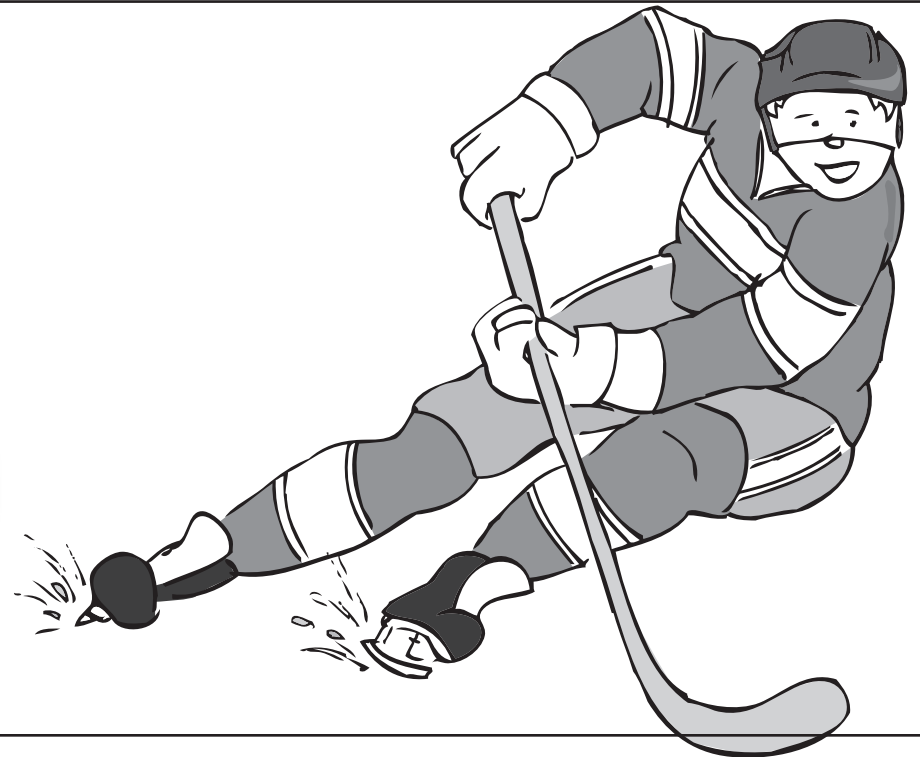
After practice, all the players are tired.
