
Elegant Eiffel Tower

France is often represented by the Eiffel Tower. This iron tower, called the Great Iron Lady is 324 metres high and is found in Paris. It was built in 1889 by the famous Gustave Eiffel for the World's Fair.

It is now your turn to represent France by creating one of its most famed monuments, the Eiffel Tower. Represent the landscape of the great Eiffel Tower.

Step I: Paint the background of your landscape. Paint the sky blue and add white clouds. If you have sponges, you can use them to make clouds. You can also use cotton balls and stretch them out to make clouds. Next you will have to make a green band which will represent grass.

Step 2: Colour the Eiffel Tower drawing, cut it out and glue it on your painted background. Your landscape of France is now complete. For a challenge, you can draw small people at the bottom of the tower. If you have good proportions, the people at the bottom of the tower will be really small. You can measure yourself and compare your size with the size of the real Eiffel Tower.
