Masterful Mosaics

Morocco is a country that is warm year-round. In order to properly represent it in a mosaic, different sized circles must be superimposed and coloured in with warm colours.







Warm colours: Colours that make us think of daytime rather than nighttime, of fire, sun or summertime (red, yellow and orange).

Overlay: To organize elements by placing them over each other, thereby overlapping them.

Step I:To begin, you must find various round objects in your home. These objects will be used to trace your circles. You can use covers, pots, cups, bowls, etc...

Step 2: On a large paper, using a pencil, trace different sized circles using the objects that you found. Fill your paper with circles. Don't forget to overlap them (trace the different sized circles over each other).

Step 3: Use warm colours to colour the circles that you have traced. You can use both coloured pencils and markers.

Step 4: To finish, use a black felt pen to trace the outline of your circles.

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
