Player Biography



Jesperi Kotkaniemi was born in the small town of Pori, Finland and grew up there with his parents, Mikael and Kati, and his brother, Kasperi. Hockey is hugely popular in Finland. They are one of the so-called "Big Six", the unofficial group of the six strongest men's ice hockey nations. Pori has an

especially passionate hockey culture and is home to the popular Ässät team. Jesperi, Kasperi and their father all played for Ässät.

Jesperi was just 17 years old when he was drafted by the Montreal Canadiens in 2018. When he came to



Montreal for the training camp, it was the first time that he had lived away from home. The 2018 - 2019 season would bring many more "firsts" for him.

Young NHL rookies are

usually sent down to the juniors for more experience after the pre-season games. Jesperi managed the unlikely feat of being selected to stay with the

Canadiens NHL team in his first season. Then in October, he became the very first player born in the 2000s to play in one of the Big Four professional sports leagues in North America. His year of firsts continued on February 5th, when Jesperi set a



new Canadiens record by becoming the first player to score goals in three straight games before the age of 19. What are some of the qualities that helped Jesperi deal with all the challenges he faced? No doubt Jesperi's easy-going nature helped him. "He's super social and happy," explained his mother. "He doesn't stress too much. He just enjoys." Maybe it also has something to do with Jesperi's last name, which in Finish means "eagle". For centuries, people have seen eagles as a symbol of courage, pride, determination, and grace.

Eagles are **tenacious**. When other birds fly away from a storm with fear, an eagle spreads its mighty wings and uses the current to soar to greater heights. Like an eagle, we can only rise to greater heights if we take up the challenges head on without running away from them.

Eagles have **vision**. Eagle's eyes are specially designed for long distance focus and clarity. They are very attentive and will sit very still to observe what is happening below, around and above them. Then they will swoop down to capture their prey.

Eagles are **fearless**. An eagle will never surrender to the size or strength of its prey. It will always fight hard to win its prey or regain its territory. They face problems head on and don't back down.

With the characteristics of the mighty eagle and his trademark smile, Jesperi is sure to continue to soar to great heights with the Montreal Canadiens!

Game of the week

This is a two-player game of strategy for developing critical thinking skills. The aim of the game is for the rocket to rise thru the atmosphere filled with satellites and reach the stars. The satellites are trying to block the rocket's assent.

Instructions:

- Glue the tokens below onto a piece of carboard or construction paper. Then cut out each token.
- Glue the second page of the lesson plan (with the board game image) onto a piece of cardboard or construction paper.
- The game pieces can also be laminated for durability.

Rules:

- I. One player is the rocket, the other player is the satellites.
- 2. To begin the game, place the rocket on the Rocket@School logo on the board and the satellites on the images of Cosmo.
- 3. Each turn, the rocket can move diagonally backwards or forwards one square only. The satellites can only move **down** the board diagonally towards the rocket one square at a time. The satellites cannot move back up the board.
- 4. Each turn the rocket must move, and one satellite must move.
- 5. The Rocket always goes first.
- 6. The satellites win the game by cornering the rocket so that it cannot make a move.
- 7. The rocket wins the game by getting across the atmosphere and making it to the stars.
